Mission Statement

Grace on Wings provides transport to patients who are needing to go for important treatment throughout the United States.

Who Qualifies for Assistance?

To qualify, the patient must:

be non-ambulatory

require medical care en route.

lack the financial resources or insurance coverage to pay for a commercial air ambulance service.

not have active or untreated MRSA, VRE, or TB.

Target Population & Benefit

Grace on Wings provides cost-effective medical airplane transport for individuals needing to travel to or from the Midwest area for treatment. Our charity air ambulance service is available for those who are:

Too ill for commercial flight

Too ill for long distance ground transportation

Unable to afford transportation to access critical medical care located at a distance

To be eligible, you or a family member must have a condition requiring medically-supervised transport of a distance of at least 150 miles.

Volunteers

Grace on Wings is staffed with professionals who volunteer their time. Our chief pilot has specialized MU2 training and has over 4000 flight hours. Flights taken are always flown with the chief pilot, a trained copilot, and two trained medical crew members including a physician assistant, RN or EMT-
